- Aware there is an ongoing seaweed harvesting project in Shimoni, further aware that there is a planned port extension in Shimoni that will affect the seaweed project, cognizant that Tsunza (Kinango ward) is surrounded by the Indian Ocean, concerned that the seaweed project maybe affected by the port extension and seaweed harvesters may lose their livelihoods,
 - a) Can the County Government conduct a feasibility study as to whether the seaweed harvesting project can be extended to Tsunza Island? (**Hon. Alfred Bavu- MCA Kinango Ward**)

- Aware that the County Assembly passed the Early Childhood Development and Education Act in 2016, further aware that the Act provides for quality, administration, licensing and registration procedures of all Early Childhood Development Education Centers (ECDE) within the County, cognizant that the County Government has constructed ECDE centers and employed teachers and caregivers, concerned that there are ECDE centers that have substandard structures and are not licensed and operating with unqualified teachers;
 - a) What is the county government doing to ensure that all the ECDE centers are licensed and employing qualified teachers?
 - b) What is the County Government doing to ensure the quality of early childhood education is not compromised in the County? (**Hon. Pokea Sikukuu-Nominated MCA**)

- Aware that Kenya's Ministry of Health signed a two year contract in 2018 to bring 100 Cuban doctors in the Country, further aware that this move was meant to improve Kenya's healthcare system especially in the rural areas, cognizant that Kwale County benefitted from this programme and Cuban doctors were deployed to Kwale;
 - a) Has Kwale benefited from this program?
 - b) What impact have the Cuban doctor made since their deployment in the Country? (**Hon. Hanifa Mwajirani-Nominated MCA**)
